1. Terms

"website" - the www.nortonownersclub.org website
"forum, message board" - the message board facility on the website
"Club" - the club, us, we, The Norton Owners Club Ltd

2. Introduction

The club operates the website for the benefit of its members under the direction of The Norton Owners Club Limited and the club's webmaster. One of the facilities of the website is a message board/forum, where members may post and respond to information and views from other members.

3. Terms of Service

The website and message board are operated by volunteers and as such, are provided on a 'best efforts' service. Service is not guaranteed, and may be suspended or removed without notice. You should not rely in any way on the service being available; no liability is accepted for its non-availability. Use of the message board is at your own risk.

Any material/data downloaded from the site is at your own risk, you are solely responsible for any damage to your computer or any loss of data resulting from such download. Whilst access to the website and message board is offered as standard to all members, there is no automatic right to use them, and members may be suspended from them at any time, subject to the procedures defined in the company's articles of association and bye-laws.

4. Posting

In order to post on the message board, you must be logged into the website, using your user name that is set up when you become a member. You are responsible for all use of your user name. Do not:

- disclose your password to anyone
- allow anyone else to use your user name
- use anyone else's user name
- attempt to impersonate anyone

With the exception of the 'Off Topic' board, material posted must be relevant to the board it is posted on.

We reserve the right to:

- Move content to a more applicable board
- Edit content to correct inaccuracies
- Delete inappropriate postings

We would encourage you to be polite and reasonable when posting. Postings must not contain matter that is false, defamatory, libellous, intentionally inaccurate, illegal, abusive, harmful, vulgar, hateful, harassing, obscene, profane, threatening, overtly offensive, invasive of a person's privacy, or otherwise objectionable. Such material may be removed without notice.

The company can be held legally liable for forum content; accordingly content that in the opinion of the club's webmaster or company board, could leave the club open to legal action will be removed without notice.

6. Viruses

Do not post any material containing viruses, or any other software intended to disrupt the Clubs computer, or anyone else's.

7. Advertising

Advertising is forbidden on the forums. Any advertising posted will be removed without notice.

We would advise you not to post personal information about yourself –the majority of the forums are open to the general public and we have no control over who views them.
