## Application for an Age Related Registration

## For re-assembled Original Machines. See NOC Official Date Letter (NOC 2)

Where your vehicle does not have a registration number you may apply for an age related one. This only applies to vehicles which have been re-assembled from the original vehicle. The majority of parts must be from the same period or 25 years of age to qualify. If at some period a replacement engine has been required, it is generally accepted that this is permissible or any other major singular part for that matter, other than the frame. It follows that the machine must represent a true likeness of the model specification..

In order to apply to the NOC for an Official Date Letter/NOC2 you must have the following:

- A completed application NOC/2 form from the Club.
- The fully assembled machine should be complete and roadworthy. Do not apply if the machine is not assembled or you have just the frame only.
- Images of both side of the machine in its current condition (2copies of each) signed and dated.
- Sharp images of both Frame No. and Engine No including all pre-fixes (2 copies of each) signed and dated.
- Please note: it may be necessary to remove the paint to verify the number we
  cannot proceed with the application if the number is not clear. We often receive
  images that would be acceptable if the image was in focus, once again this
  holds up the process. Do not however try to enhance the number other than
  highlighting the digits. For instance by trying to over stamp the original
  number if the number is weak or damaged send it as is.

## FOR THE DVLA APPLICATION ALSO see below:-

- When applying to the DVLA on receiving the NOC documentation you will require the following.
- A completed V55/5 which you can download from the DVLA for guidance in filling the form, see below:
- Page 1 Section 2,6,7,8,9,10,27,30,31,32,33(45,46) only if you have the information.
- Page 2 Sections 48,49,50. if the Club is helping with the application do not forget to sign and date page 2.
- A current MoT certification for the vehicle only if applicable post 1960.
- A completed V112 form if the vehicle is MOT exempt. This can also be downloaded from the DVLA.
- If the machine following the factory record search was originally exported you will be expected to check with HMRC (NOVA) this will be indicated on the NOC letter for the DVLA. (Tel 0300 200 3700 for a paper application form. DVLA will not complete the application until this has been achieved.

On completion of V55/5 you will be expected to provide the following documentation. (Photocopies accepted)

- Confirmation of Name (one only from the list.)
- Birth or Marriage certificate, Decree nisi absolute, Passport, Driving License both paper or photo type.
- Confirmation of Address (one only from list)
- Utility Bill received in the last 3months.
- Council Tax Bill, Medical Card,
- Building Society or Bank statements all of which contain your address.
- The payment to the DVLA is £55 made payable to the DVLA.

Note: On Insurance it would be advisable to contact your Insurance Company and cover the machine on the frame number. This however is not a requirement for the initial registration purpose at present.

Note: The NOC may inspect the machine if found necessary there will be extra costs involved if this is the case. The DVLA are arranging for machines to be inspected by SGS under contract to the DVLA they will make arrangements with you personally after they receive your initial application currently.
