The first two are known and recommended:

The Golden Lion has 5 (maybe 6 soon) recently refurbished rooms. Prices are £100 or so per night. New owners are in the pub so the social media and website aren't up yet. The hotel does not have any secure parking per se, but there is a beer garden at the back which they might let you use...I haven't asked! Great food and drink.

However, it is right next to the rugby club so you may not need secure parking...leave your bike(s) with a mate who's camping. Their rooms are from around £60 and I hear mixed reviews. Bar food and drinks available.
